

SAL Squadron 552 Meeting Minutes
25 June 2026

The meeting was called to order by SAL Commander Jeremy Milam to conduct the business to come before Squadron 552; the meeting started at 1805 hours.

The opening ceremony consisted of Chaplain's prayer, Pledge of Allegiance, and reading of the Preamble to the Constitution of the Sons of the American Legion. The meeting quorum was met with the attendance of five members.

Meeting minutes of the last meetings were read with no change; accordingly, they stand as published.

Finance Officer: The status of funds was provided and questions were answered.

UNFINISHED/OLD BUSINESS (via the notes from the previous two meetings):

1. It was recommended during the March meeting that a cleaning contractor be contacted for bids due to the lack of cleanliness in the kitchen, restrooms, and elsewhere. This was again brought to the attention of the Facility Committee (April, May and June meetings) without result. Since this is both a health and safety issue due to the need for the kitchen and restroom to be clean at all times, this organization is again asking for positive consideration. It seems that funds exist and the membership cannot understand why this is not approved. A one time cleaning, as recently done, is not sufficient.
2. SAL shirts were discussed and it was resolved to work with Gabe Rowin to obtain the shirts.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. It was unanimously approved to donate \$137.50 to the Auxiliary for backpacks.
2. It was unanimously approved to allocate the sum not to exceed \$250.00 for expenses related to the ceremony to honor recently deceased SAL member Donald McHugh.
3. It was unanimously approved to allocate the sum not to exceed \$150.00 for the purchase of two chairs for the outside patio, such as what was recently purchased via Amazon.
4. SAL will be cooking hotdogs, etc., on the 4th of July and it was unanimously approved to allocate funds for the purchase of food-related items, if necessary.
